

How to actually pick an **alert tool**.

Several reservation alert tools exist for Disney dining. The right one fits your trip, not whichever name you heard first. Google anything here you want to verify.

The things that actually separate one alert tool from another. Score any tool, including this one, against all seven before you pay.

CRITERIA THAT MATTER

THE EVALUATION

What to actually evaluate

Not a competitor trash-talk, just the questions that change which tool is right for your trip.

Watch limit	One must-have reservation vs. five experiences for a family trip are very different asks.
Alert channels included	Some tools charge extra for SMS. Know exactly what you get at each price point.
Check cadence, published?	"Real-time" means nothing without a number. How often does a paid watch actually check?
Coverage beyond dining	Enchanting Extras are harder to catch and are often ignored entirely.
Booking flow	The tool should send you to Disney's official site to complete the booking yourself.
Credential handling	A trustworthy tool never stores your Disney login. No exceptions.
Business model	VC-backed or founder-run changes how price hikes and feature cuts tend to happen.

◉ WHAT SPOTSITTER DOES DIFFERENTLY

Five levers, stated plainly.

01



Enchanting Extras coverage

Most tools are built around dining. SpotSitter watches BBB, Savi's, Droid Depot, La Cava, and dessert parties too. If it opens on Disney's system, we catch it.

02



All channels in the base paid tier

Founder (\$49/mo) includes SMS, push, email, and Discord, no add-ons. Some competitors treat SMS as a paid upgrade. We don't.

03



Published check cadence

Free checks every 120 seconds, paid every 60, in writing, on the page. Most competitors won't put a number on 'real-time.'

04



PWA, no app store required

Add it to your home screen from Safari or Chrome. No App Store delay, no Play Store gatekeeper. Works on iOS and Android today.

05



Independent and founder-operated

Not a VC product. Pricing is public, with no surprise tier restructuring. Built by the family that caught a Cake Bake reservation after 2,395 automated checks.

No tool catches every opening.

A spot can appear and vanish in seconds. What a tool does is check far more often than a person can, and tell you the moment a slot appears.

Pick the one whose limits, channels, cadence, and coverage fit your trip, and that puts all of it in writing. The rest is you and Disney's booking flow.
